



## **1<sup>st</sup> Annual ATV Poker Run Fundraiser Rules**

1. The Hillsborough Community Center, Inc., or any organization or individual associate in any way with this event; do not assume liability for any claims which may arise as a result of your participation in this event.
2. By signing below, you assume all liability and responsibility related to your participation of any and all passengers, individual or riders in your vehicles.
3. The route will start at Grimes Field and is approximately 10-12 miles utilizing state-approved ATV trails. The Poker Run is open to ANY legally registered OHRV, (refer any questions concerning registrations to the NH Fish and Game Department, [www.wildnh.com](http://www.wildnh.com)).
4. All participants will be required to adhere to all local, state, and federal laws and assume all fines and penalties related to his or her noncompliance. The committee, organizers or officials assume no responsibility.
5. Must be 18 years of age or older to win prizes.
6. All paid entries and/or additional poker hands will be issued a score card (see attached). These score cards will serve as the individuals/participants poker hand.
7. Cost: Entry fee is \$10.00 if registered online; \$20.00 in person at event start. With a paid entry, participants will receive 1 (one) score card. (No refunds).
8. All participants must participate in at least one game of skill at a checkpoint, and this participation must be noted on the scorecard.
9. The Poker Run will start promptly at 12:00 p.m. (noon), riders will return to Grimes Field parking lot by 2:30 p.m., and the event will end promptly at 3:00 p.m. after the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners are declared. Remember this is NOT a race.
10. Participants will draw their first playing card at Grimes Field during registration, the second, third, and fourth cards at the designated checkpoints, and the fifth upon returning to Grimes Field.
11. Participants will receive only one playing card draw per score card at each checkpoint and participants purchasing additional scorecards will draw all additional playing cards individually.
12. Playing cards drawn at a checkpoint must verified, score cards signed, and recorded prior to departing a checkpoint. Incomplete score cards, score cards that have been and/or appear to be altered, defaced, changed and/or tampered with will be discarded and disqualified and in



additional score cards purchased by that party will be disqualified. There will be no exceptions to this rule. A signature from each individual checkpoint personnel will be required on all score cards submitted. Cards drawn must match your scorecard at the end of the event.

13. No duplication playing cards maybe drawn. (Example: participant draws an ace of hearts at checkpoint and another ace of hearts at checkpoint two. Participant must return the second ace of hearts to the deck and draw another card). No five-of-a-kinds will be permitted.
14. After returning to the Grimes Field, all score cards must be turned into the committee or committee designee at the designated location as soon as possible and prior to the posted deadline, so all the score cards can be tallied and a winner announced. Any score card turned in past the posted deadline will be disqualified and will not be used to determine a winner. All qualifying score cards will be posted on our Facebook page after the event.
15. The rule in case of a tie will be a blind high card draw, between the individuals involved in the tie.
16. The penalty for breaking any rule is automatic disqualification. Other rules may be put into place the day of the event and will be announced and posted prior to the start of the event.
17. Prizes will be awarded as follows:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Place – best hand
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Place – best decorated/most patriotic ATV
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Place – worst hand.
18. All decisions of the committee judges are final.
19. Participants must be present to win.

*I am 18 years of age or older. I agree to abide by the rules in this document. My vehicle is a legally registered OHRV with the state of New Hampshire. I understand that I am riding at my own risk, carry my own insurance, and hold harmless the Hillsborough Community Center, Inc. during my participation.*
